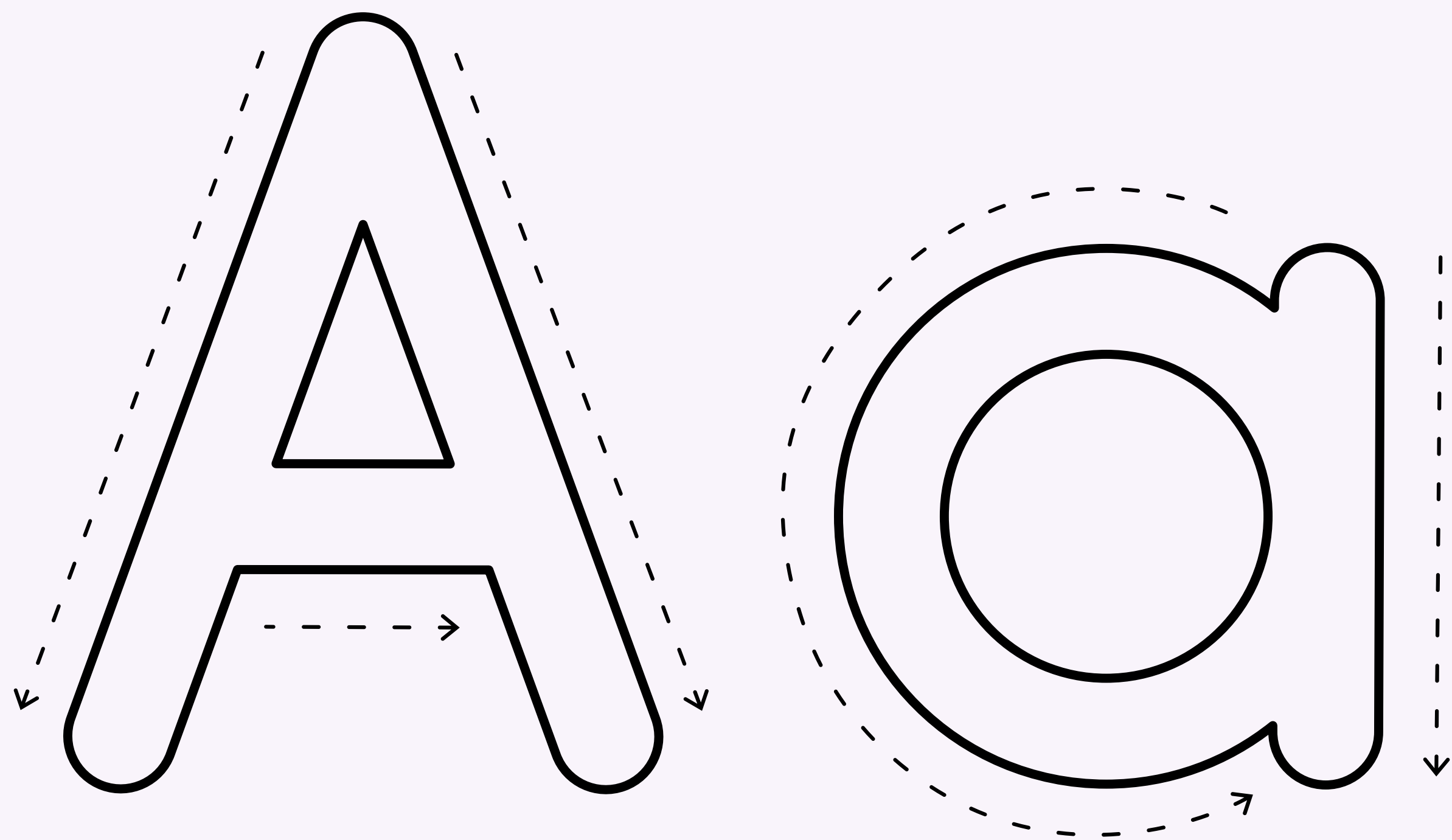
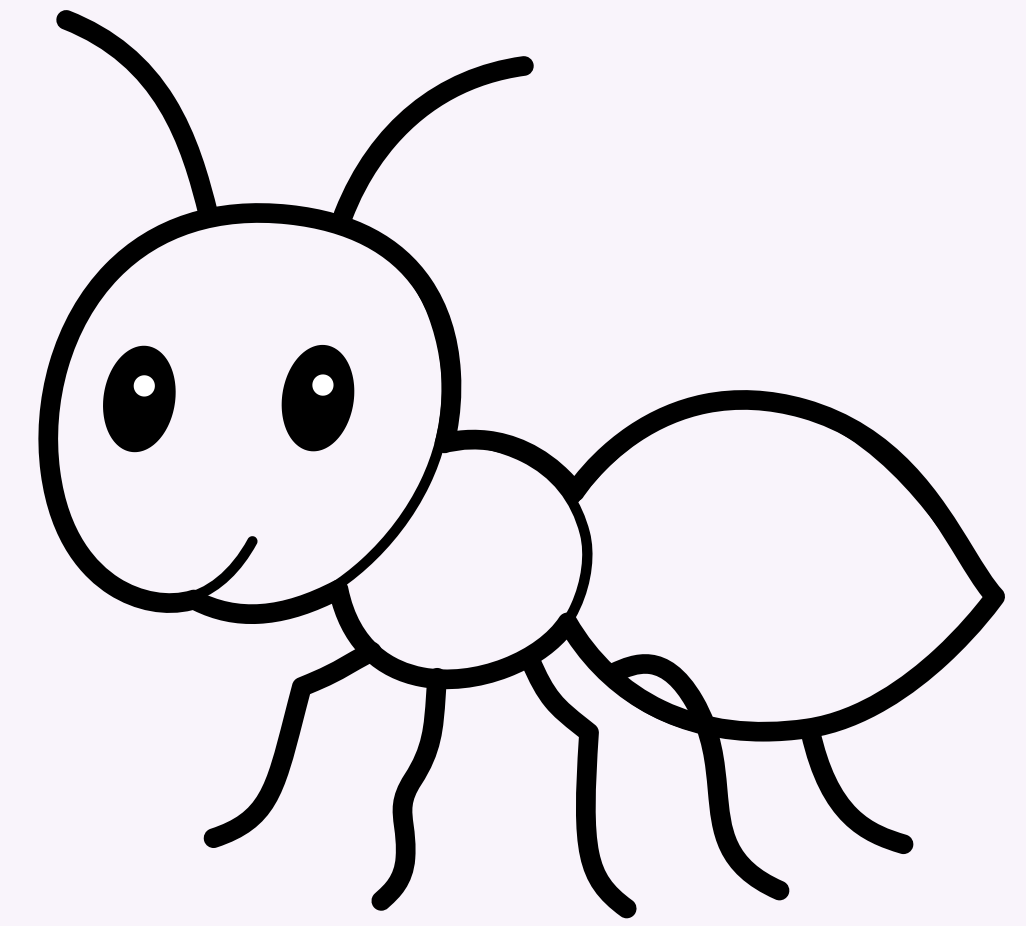
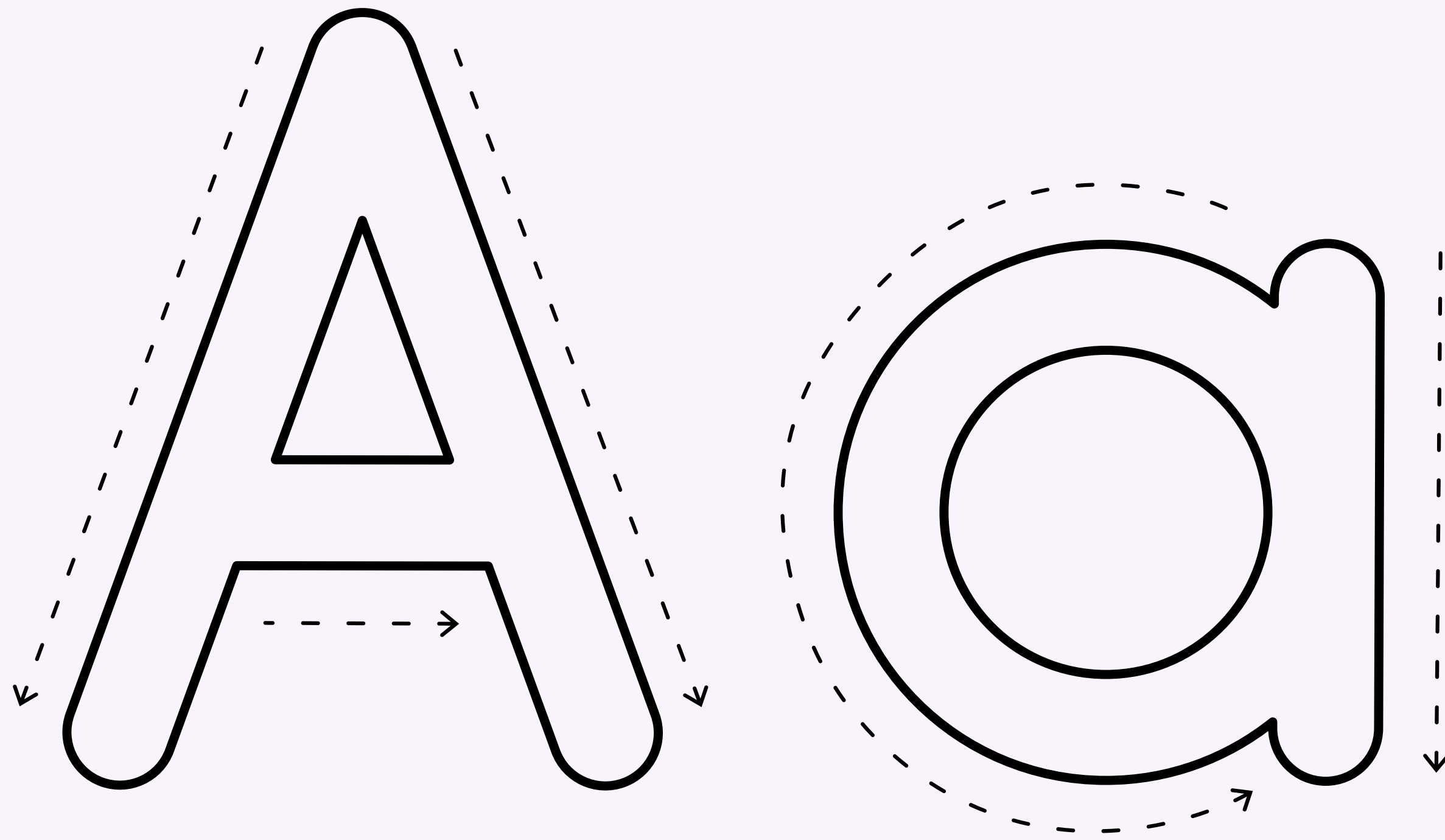
## HOW TO USE THIS BUNDLE

- 3** Trace the big letter first, following the red arrow, then the smaller practice letters
- 4** Use the blank practice lines for extra repetition, or skip them if one pass feels like enough



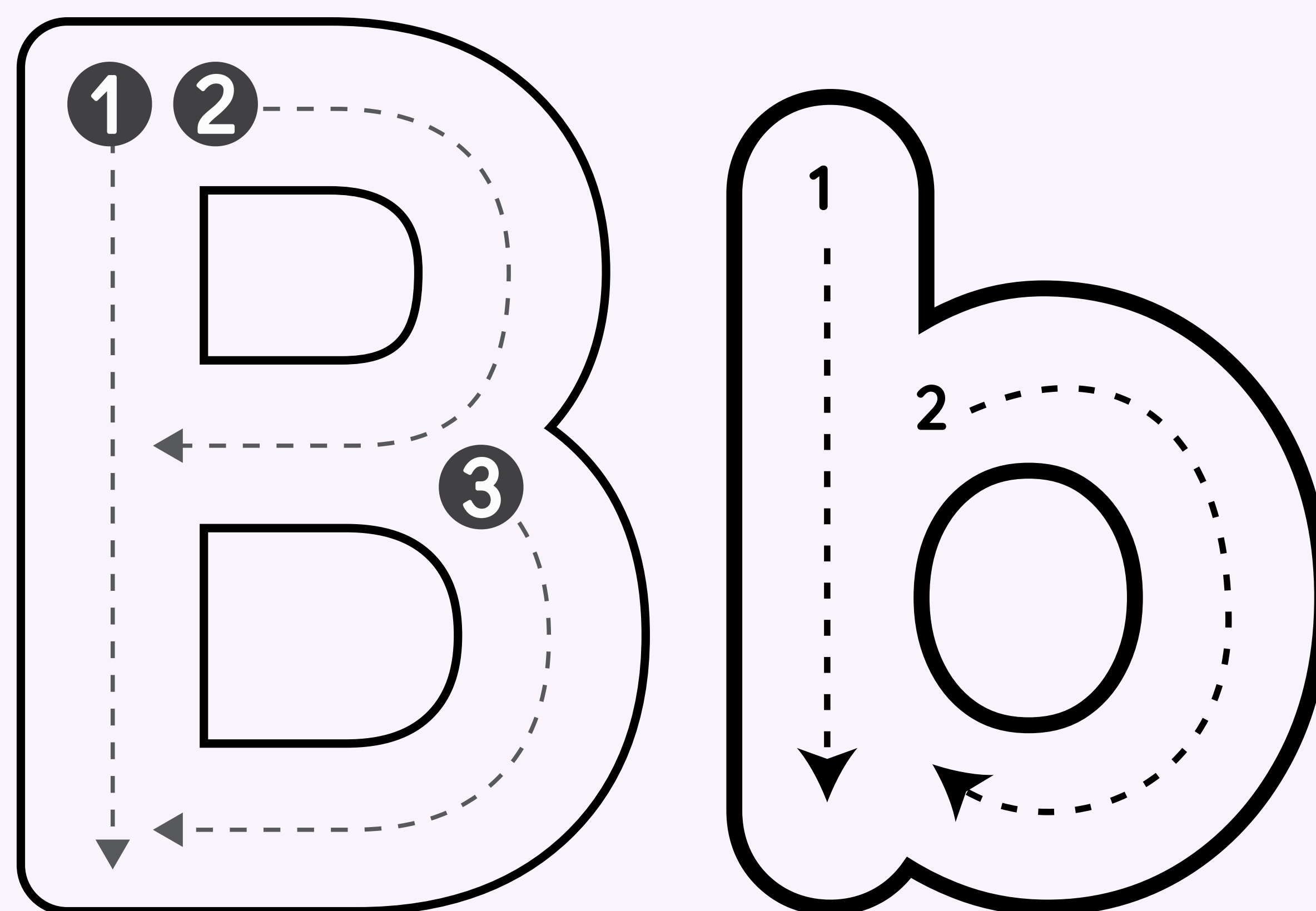
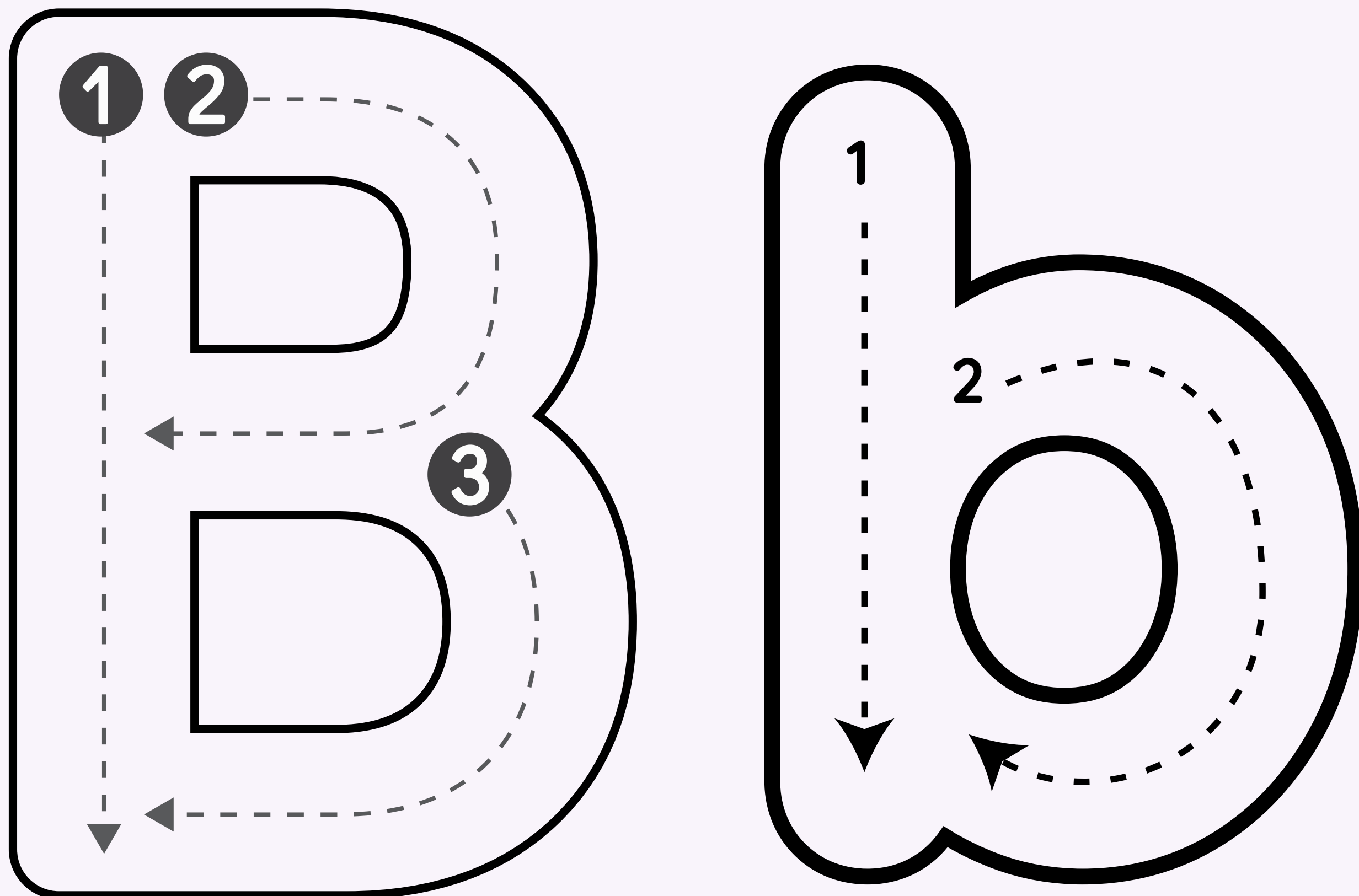

**Can you find the 5 words that start with A? You just traced that letter!**



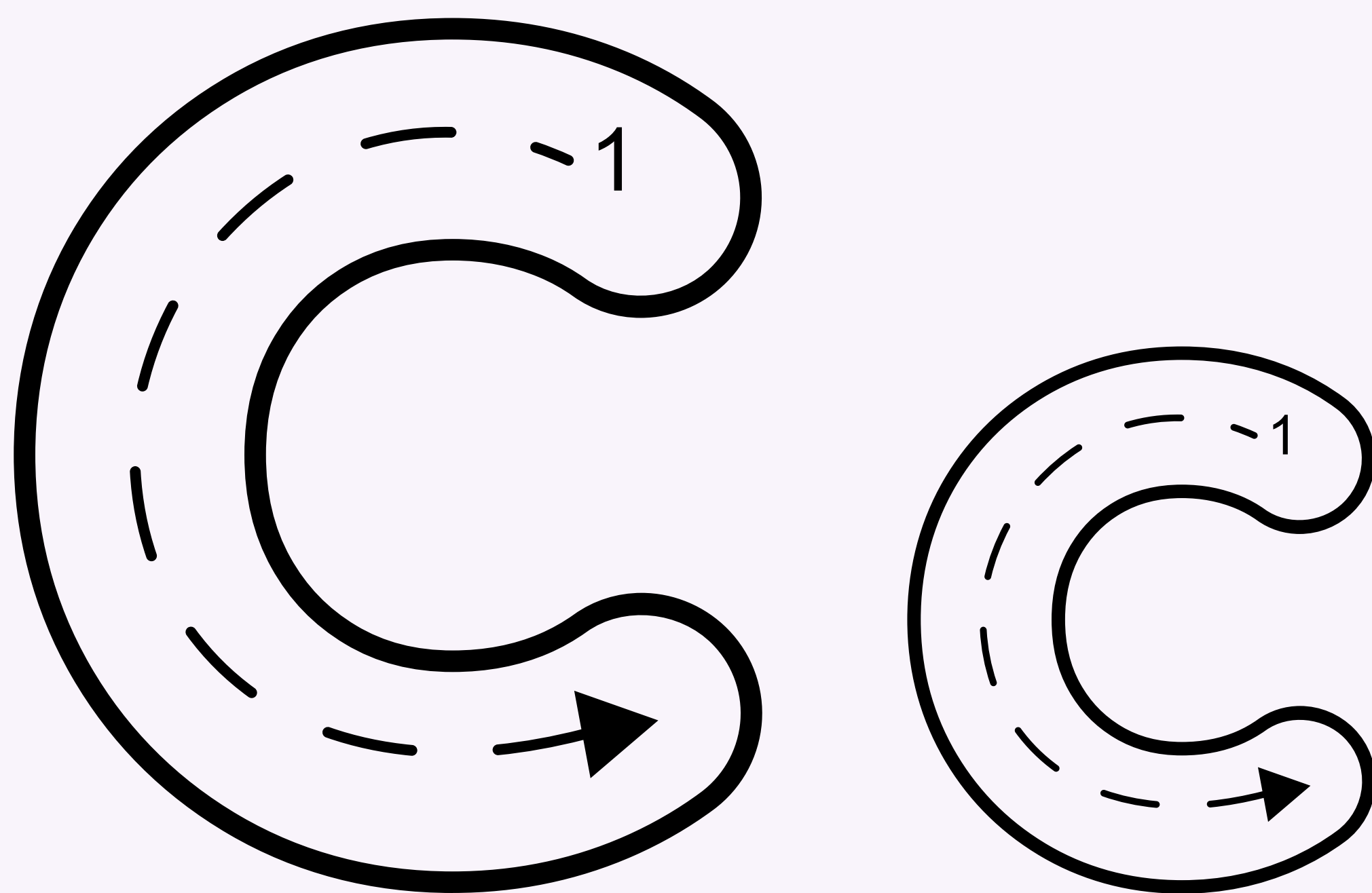
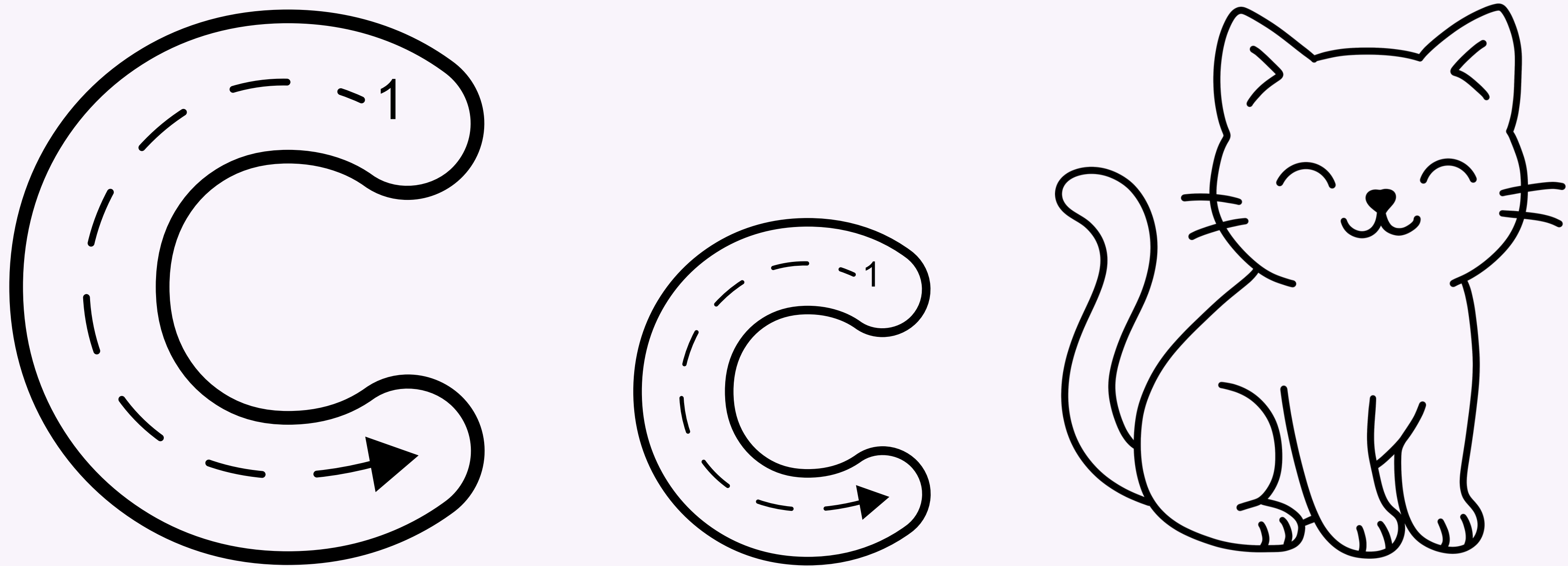
**Bella the bunny bounces through the big blue meadow**



**Can you find the 5 words that start with B? You just traced that letter!**



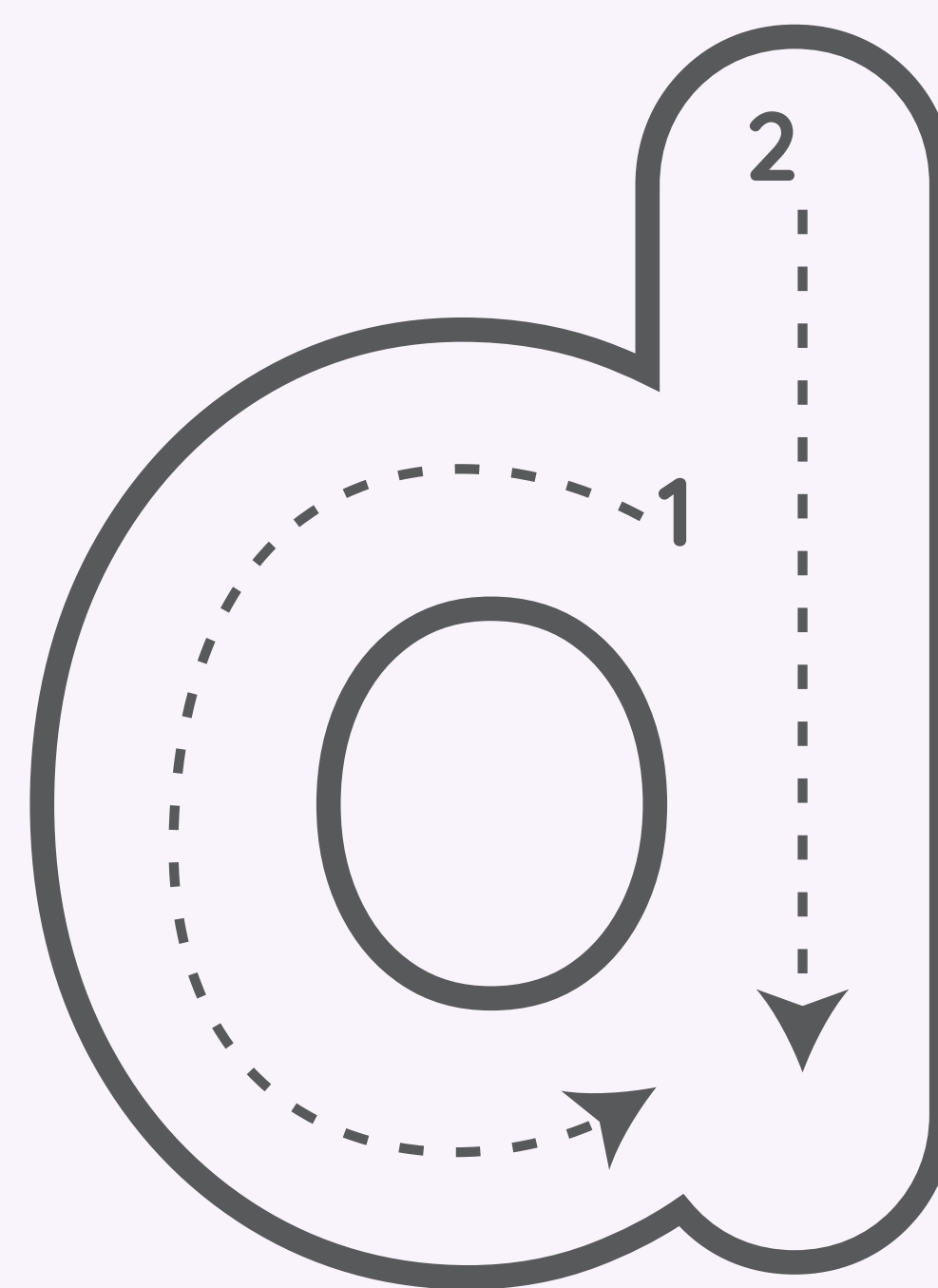
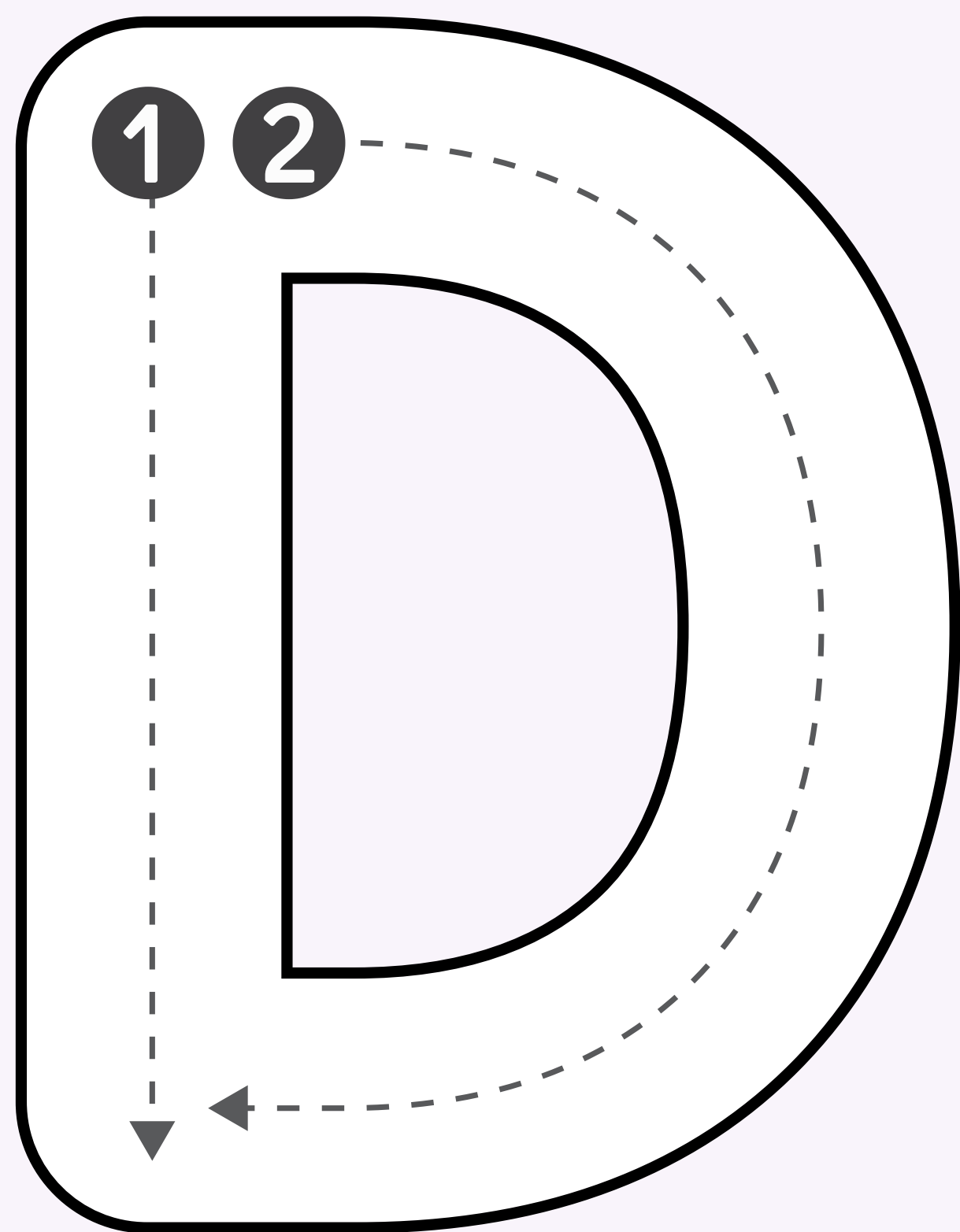
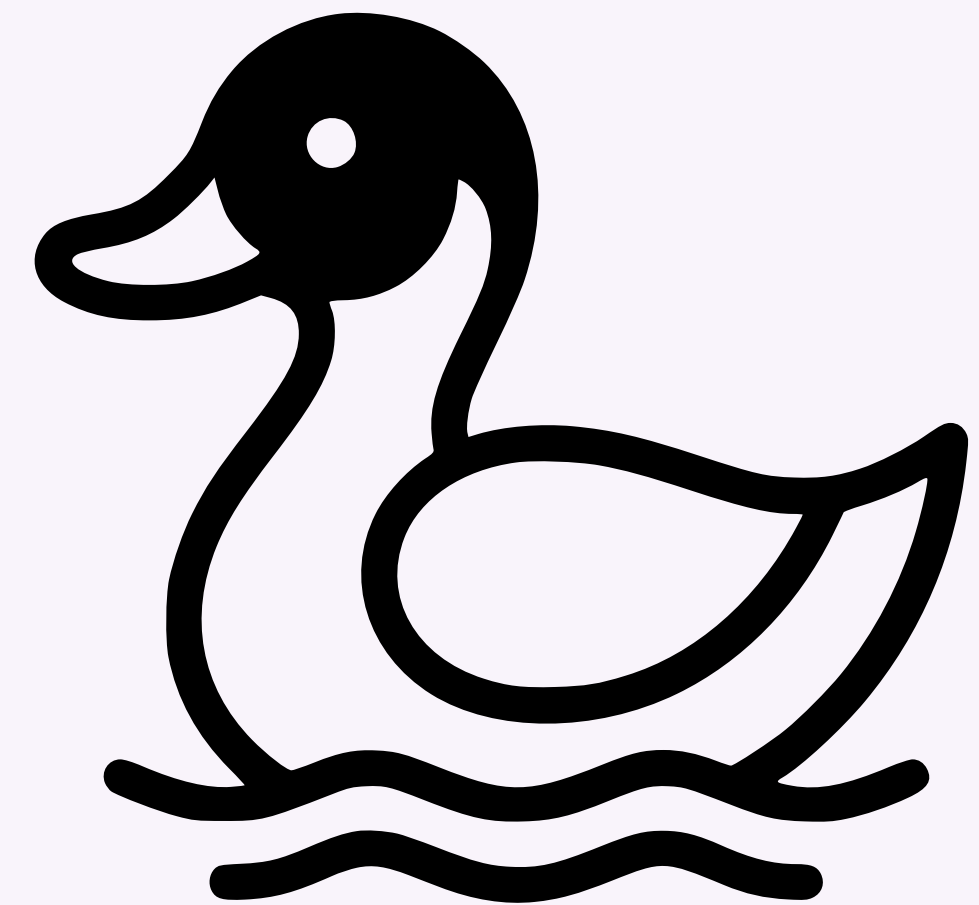
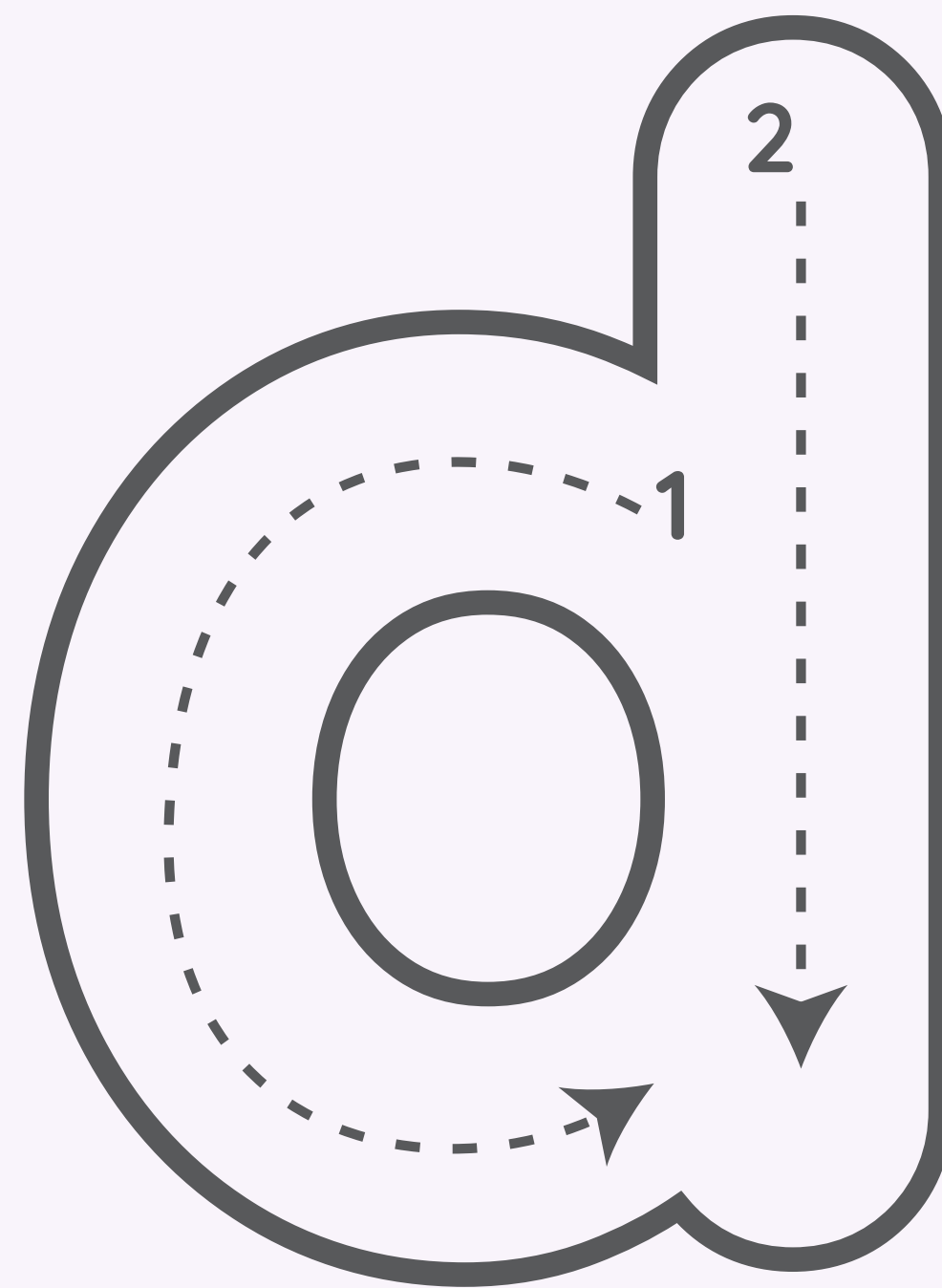
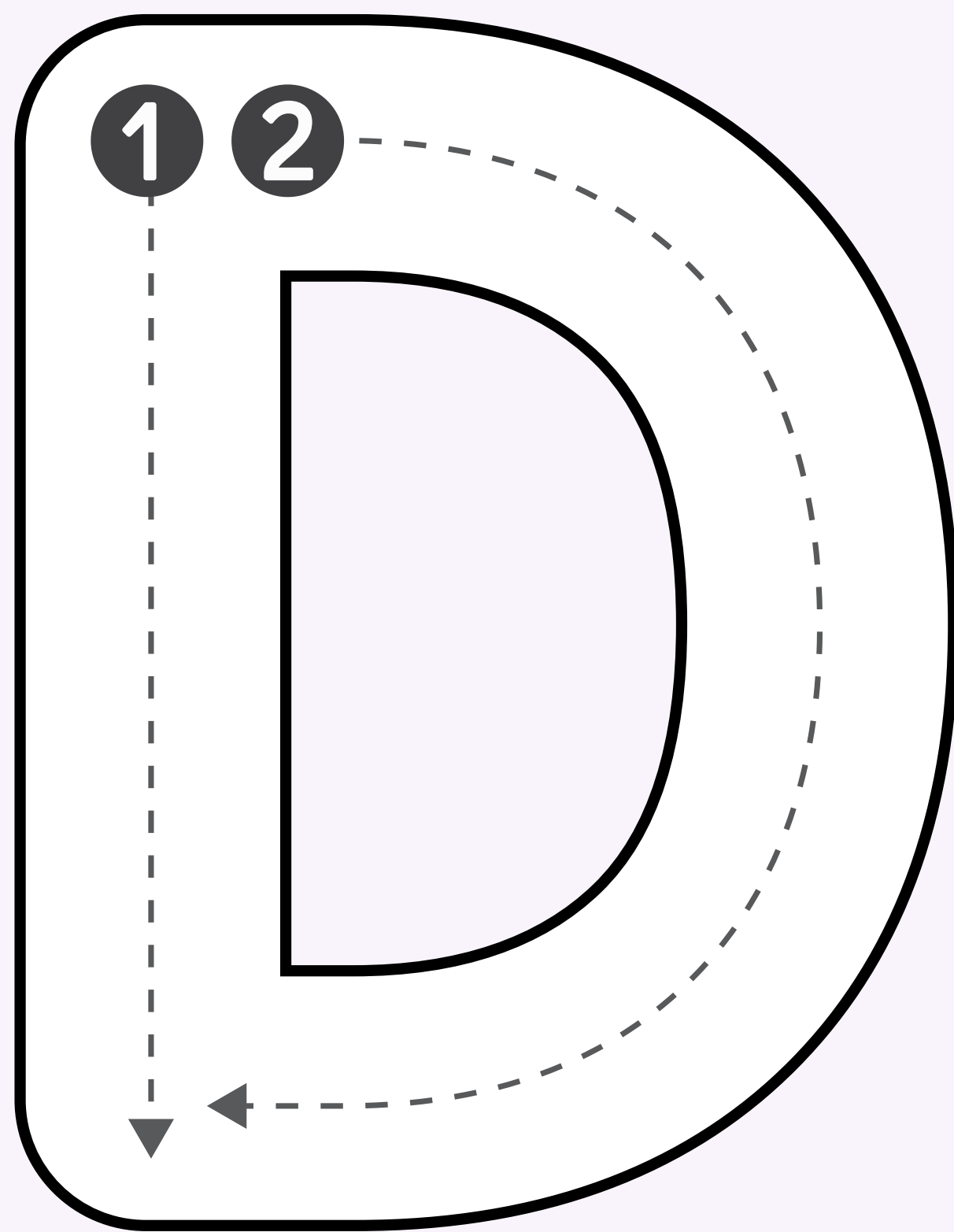

**Can you find the 5 words that start with C? You just traced that letter!**



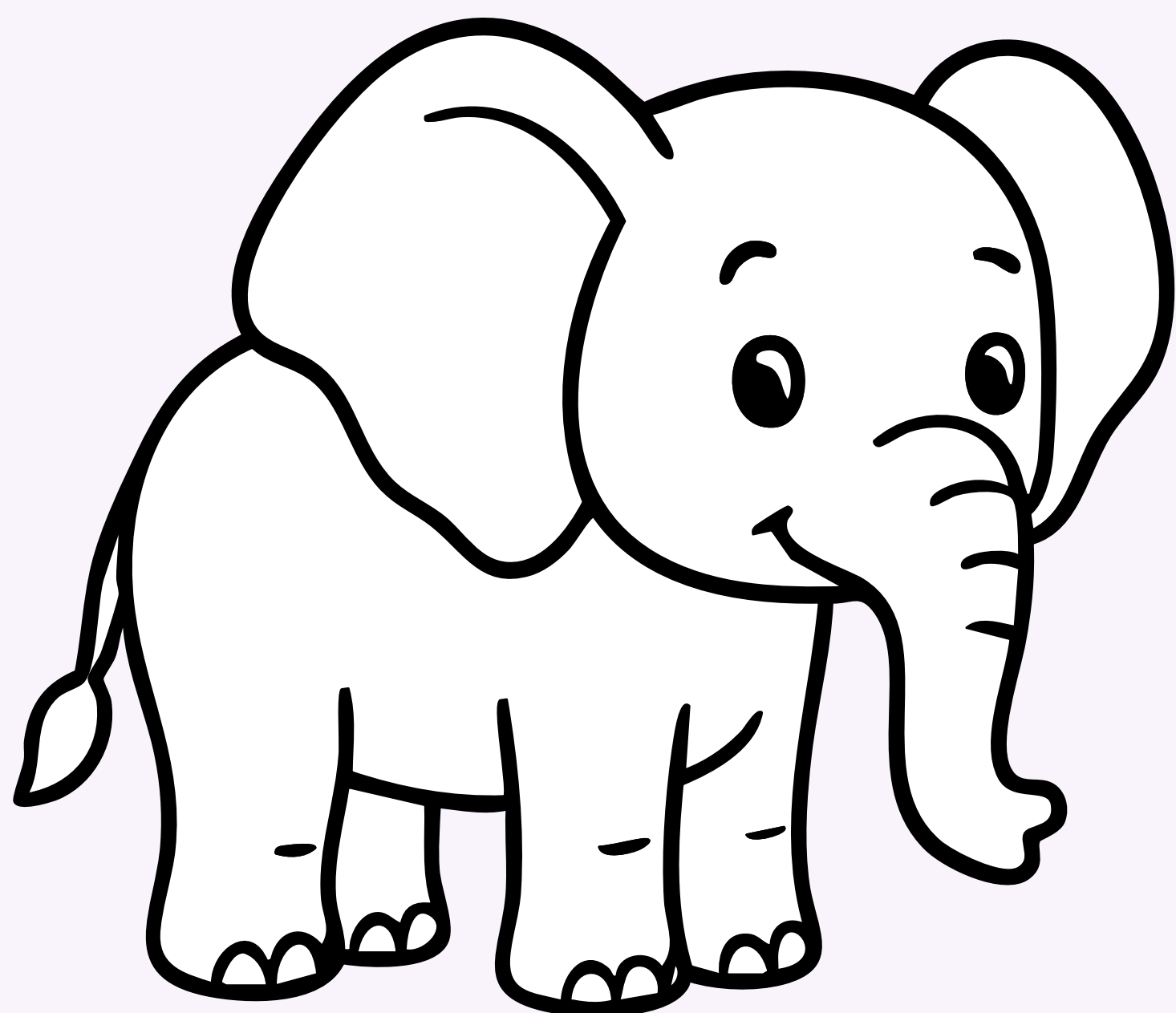
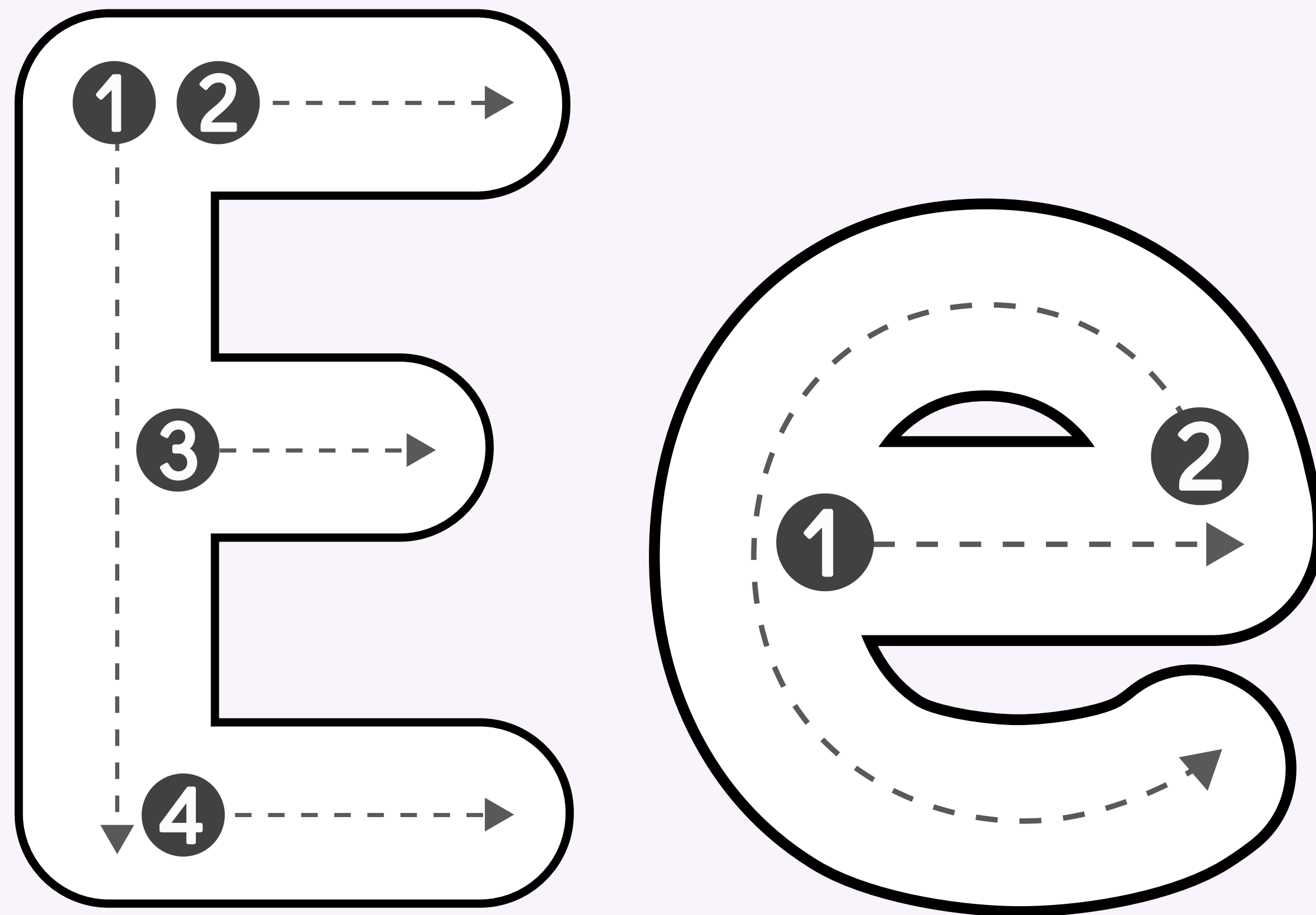
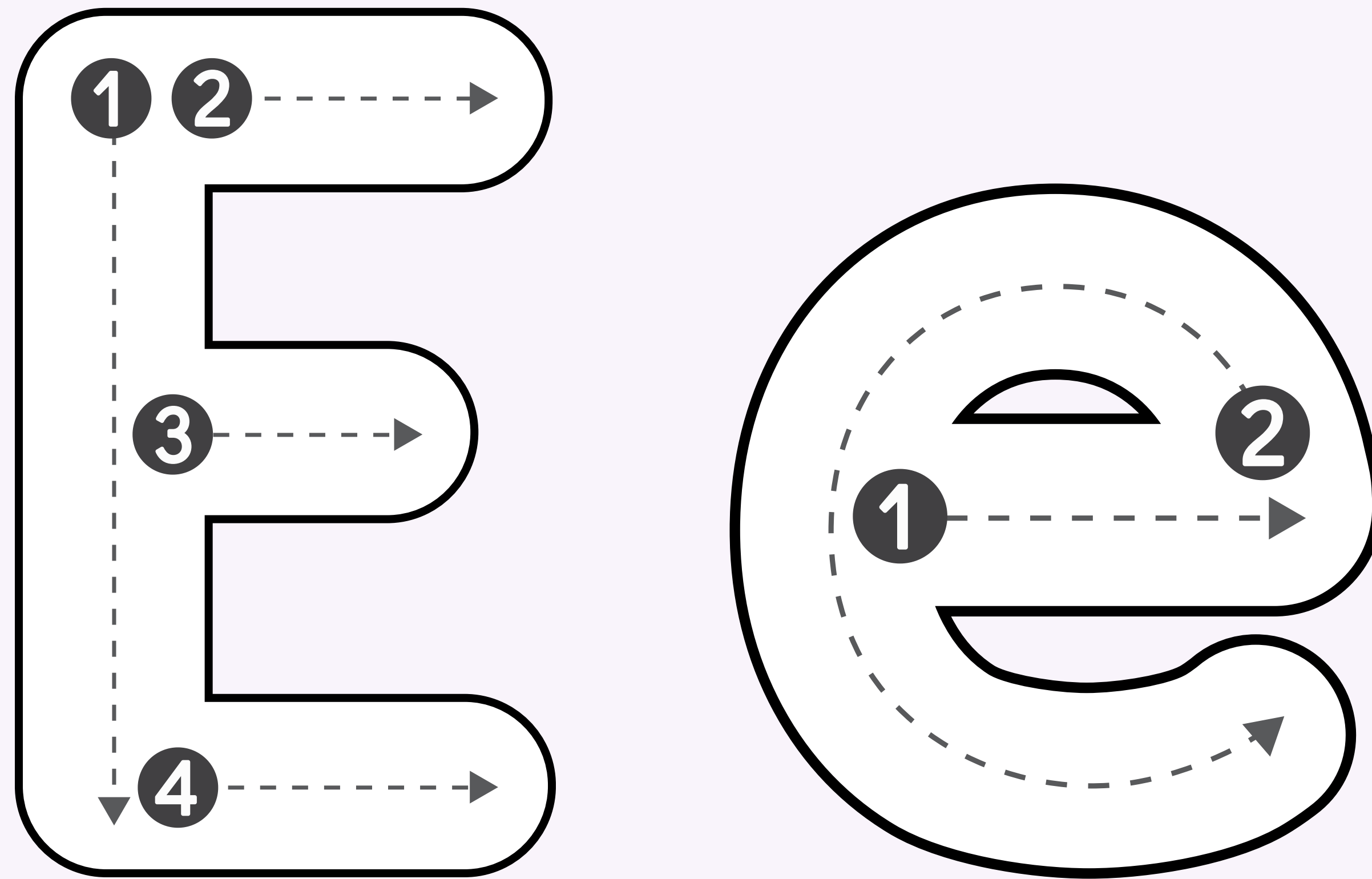

**Can you find the 4 words that start with D? You just traced that letter!**



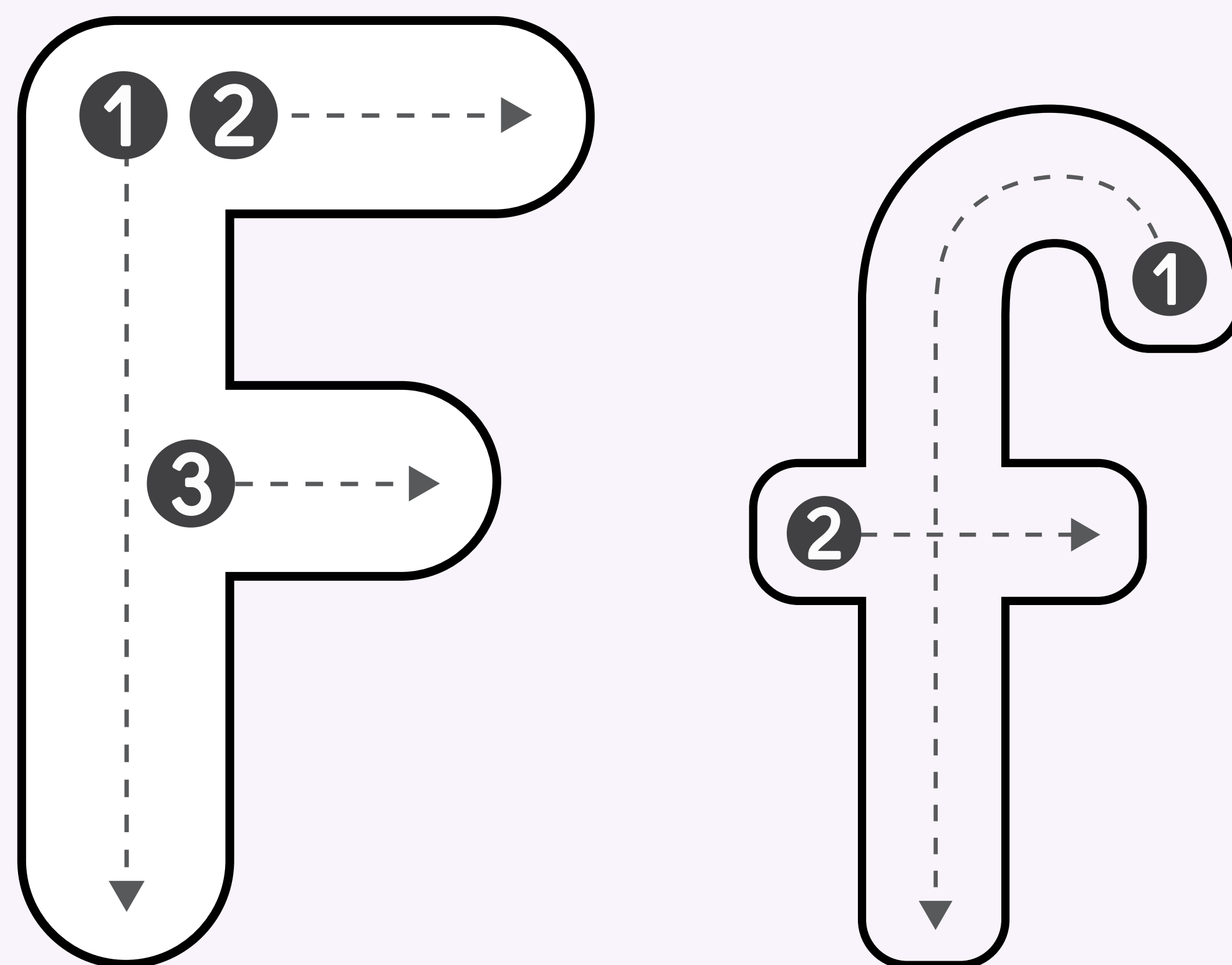
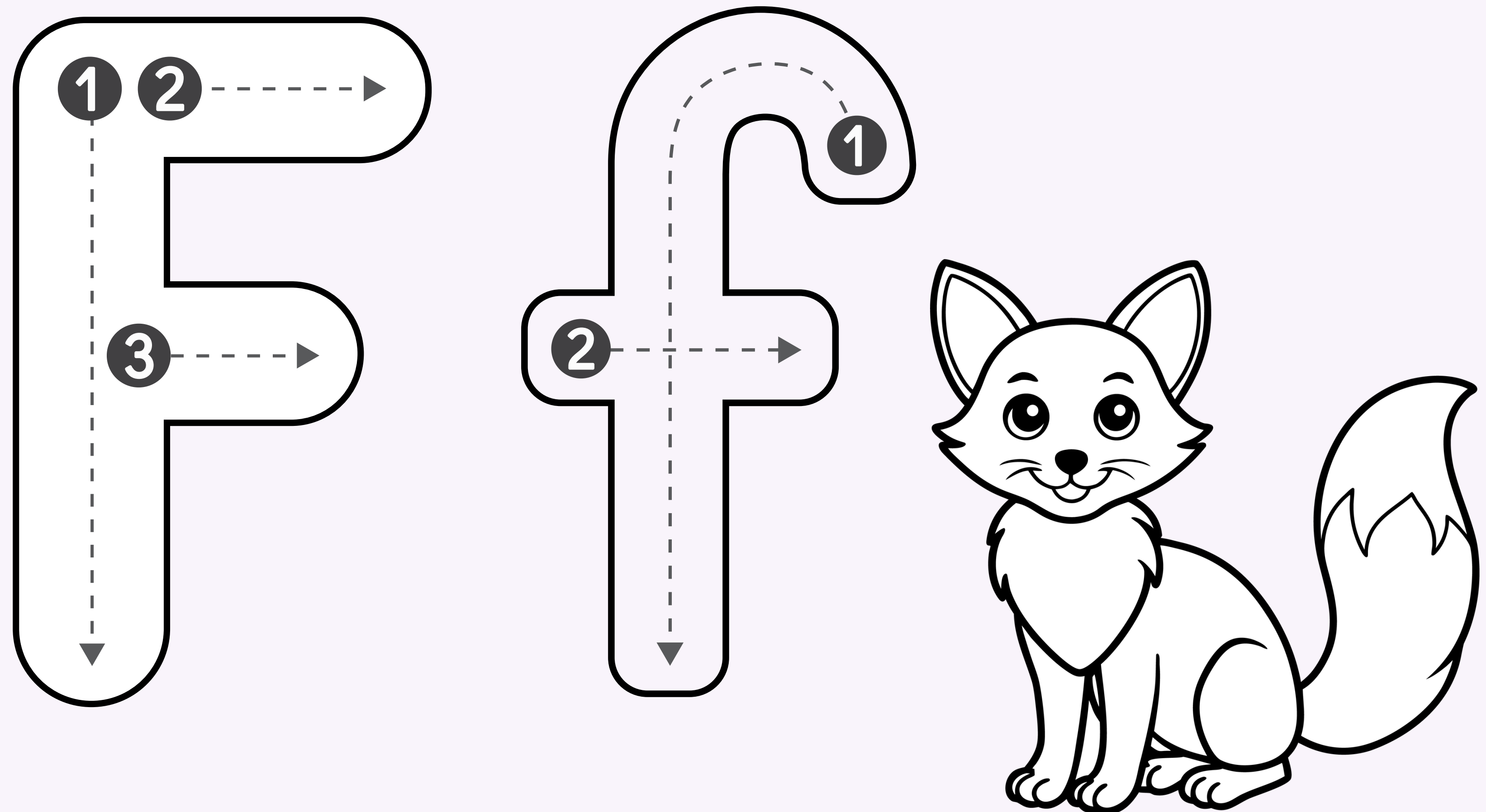
**Ellie the elephant explores an enormous echoing cave.**
